Overview

The Specialty Head of School and/or education faculty will have provided NHS England SW with a list of courses suitable to attend. The list is an aid for postgraduate doctors in training to identify the most appropriate time to attend courses during their programme.

Courses may be accessed at certain points throughout a PG DiT's training. If the course has been identified over multiple years, you may only attend the course once, unless specified in the notes.

Courses are split into three categories. Each category determines the level of funding you will receive from the study leave budget.
